- \* PAPER - WIDE RULE
- 1 PKG. OF TABBED NOTEBOOK DIVIDERS (PLASTIC RECOMMENDED) with pockets
- 2 HIGHLIGHTER PENS (one yellow one pink)
- 4 PKG. 3 X 5 INDEX CARDS (ruled/white)
- 1 SPIRAL NOTEBOOKS (wide ruled for math)
- 1 PLASTIC COVERED ONE SUBJECT SPIRAL of 100+ pages (such as 5 Star or Bright) for Social Studies
- 5 MANILA FOLDERS
- 1 PKG. GRAPH PAPER (1cm by 1cm)
- 2 PADS OF 1-1/2" X 2" STICKY NOTES
- 1 PKG. OF PLASTIC SHEET PROTECTORS (10 sheets – not opaque)
- 1 BOX COLORED, WASHABLE MARKERS (8 count)
- 1 PKG. MANILLA CONSTRUCTION PAPER (9X12)

**Additional Supply Notes:**

1. Supplies for specific courses:
  - Reading 6 PreAP students: 1 spiral bound 4x6 inch index card set
  - English 6 PreAP students: 3 packs of 3x5 blank index cards
2. All students will be required to use the school assignment book which will be purchased separately at a cost of \$3.00
3. Students in PE/athletics will be charged an annual laundry fee of \$15.00. The PE instructors will collect the fee during the first week of school.
4. Students in Exploratory Wheel will be charged a \$5 art fee. Students in band, orchestra, and choir will have fees associated with music books, shirts, etc. These fees will be collected by the teacher/directors at the beginning of the year.
5. Novels: Students will be given the opportunity to purchase the class novels assigned in Reading 6 courses for home use and annotation. Information will be provided separately.
6. Backpacks: Backpacks should be 12" x 18" x 6" or smaller (many brands including Jansport, Eastpack, Quest will work). Backpacks with wheels/pull handles do not fit in lockers and can not be used.
7. Fashion Colored pens (neons, metallic, glitter, etc) are not acceptable for school assignments and classwork.
8. A few additional unique, subject specific supplies may be required by individual teachers.
9. Several of the supplies listed will be turned into the student's advisory teacher for use throughout the year (for example, tissues, index cards...); others will be kept in the student's locker or binder.
10. Supplies will need to be restocked throughout the year.
