- 12 BLACK PENS
- 1 SET OF MAP COLORED PENCILS (full length pencils)

- * LOOSELEAF PAPER - WIDE RULED (not college rule)
- 1 PACKAGES OF NOTEBOOK DIVIDERS (5 tabs)
- 1 PACKAGE MULTICOLOR HIGHLIGHTER PENS (5 pack)
- 1 PACKAGE OF GRAPH PAPER (4 sq.=1 inch)

Additional Supply Notes:

1. Fashion Colored pens (neon, metallic, glitter, etc) are not acceptable for school assignments and classwork.
2. All students will be required to use the school assignment book which will be purchased separately at a cost of \$3.00.
3. Students in PE/athletics will be charged an annual laundry fee of \$15.00. The PE instructors will collect the fee during the first week of school.
4. Novels: Students will be given the option to purchase the class novels assigned in English 8 courses for home use and annotation. Information will be provided separately.
5. Supplies for specific courses:
 - Algebra:** Students enrolled in **Algebra I** may wish to purchase a Texas Instrument T1-84+ graphing calculator from a local office supply store. These calculators are used in Algebra as well as advanced high school math and science courses. Purchase of a T1-84+ is entirely optional; the school does have calculators of this type available for use during class.
 - Math 8, Math 8 PreAP:** Students in these courses will need access to a calculator for homework. The school has calculators available for in class use. All 8th grade classes utilize graphing calculators and so parents may wish to consider purchasing a graphing calculator, available at local office supply stores. These calculators would be useful in high school math as well.
 - Science 8:** Hurricane Tracking Chart (available free at grocery stores, hardware stores, newspaper etc.

6. Specialty electives such as art, homemaking, theater, and Industrial Technology have a material fee which will be explained at beginning of the year by the teacher. Music programs have instrument fees, uniform fees, and/or special supply needs that will be explained in the beginning of the year materials from the directors.
7. A few additional unique, subject specific supplies may be required by individual teachers.
8. Backpacks: Backpacks should be 12” x 18” x 6” or smaller (many brands including Jansport, Eastpack, Quest will work). Backpacks with wheels/pull handles do not fit in lockers and can not be used.
