What is Title 1?
Title 1 is a program funded by the federal government. It is designed to help students who are struggling in school. A school selected to be Title 1 is based on the number of families who are eligible for free or reduced meals.

What are parents' responsibilities at home & at school?

- Read and sign Title 1 letters, as well as school notices.
- Attend school meetings.
- Meet with your child's teachers, including your Title 1 teacher.
- Make sure your child attends school every day.
- Take your child to the library.
- Read with your child on a regular basis.
- Provide your child with a nutritious breakfast.
- Encourage your child's success and effort.
- Limit time for television and video games.
- Make sure homework is complete.
- Provide a homework area.
- Volunteering in the school.

What are students' responsibilities at home and at school?

- Be cooperative.
- Have good attendance.
- Be responsible for giving notices & information from school every day.
- Show respect for yourself and others.
- Always do your best.
- Make sure homework is completed.

What are the school's responsibilities?

- Hold parent-teacher conferences.
- Provide progress reports.
- Provide opportunities for parents to volunteer.
- Provide high quality curriculum and instruction to enable the children to meet the TAKS tests' standards.
