**1. Where do I find out more information about the RSVP program?**

*The best place to find detailed information is on this website on the page listed as RSVP guidelines. If you need further clarification on a particular type of community service project then ask one of the committee members also listed in the guidelines.*

**2. Who do I get to sign as a supervisor?**

*Any **adult** who is in charge of the activity who is not a parent, relative may sign as the supervisor.*

**3. How many activities do I have to have?**

*You must have three separate activities and no one activity can be more than 40% of your hours.*

*BASIC GUIDELINES:*

Collect blankets through church to distribute to the homeless	Service related only to the church—not community—i.e. bible study in your home, church choir, working in the nursery
Study hall assist faculty with projects	Activities for academic credit during your regular class time (PALS, TAFE, Cheerleaders, Drill Team)
Open House, Ram Camp, Leadership Camp	Fundraisers—i.e. for club, Penny Day, cleaning park for donation
Clubs or groups going to nursing home after school or on the weekend	Babysitting or doing yard work for a family member for no pay
Church mission trip	Club contest or activity that does not serve the community
