EXPECTATIONS: Attendance

- Students will not be excused for **detention** or **disciplinary problems** in the classroom that warrant the teacher to keep the student out of choir for that day.
- If your child is ill or needs to miss a rehearsal/concert for other commitments such as dentist/doctor appointments or family emergencies, please send a note explaining the absence so that it can be excused and marked accordingly. Attendance is taken at all rehearsals.
- If a student is tardy twice, it will count as 1 unexcused absence.

We couldn't have a successful choir without our wonderful volunteers. We will need many volunteers for our traveling performances. This includes the winter program performed at the mall and the spring performance at Sea World. Look for choir notes throughout the year letting you know more about these volunteer opportunities.
