Summer School

OAC summer coursework through computerized instruction is a self-paced program that will allow students to recover credits for courses they have previously failed, as well as providing an opportunity to earn credits toward graduation requirements.



The structure of this program provides students with an opportunity to earn up to 2 full credits during the summer session.

Courses Offered:

(*denotes courses only available for credit recovery)

- *Algebra I & II, *Geometry, *MMA
- *English I - IV
- World Geography, *World History, *US History,
- Government, Economics (for students entering 12th grade for 2009/2010)
- *IPC, *Biology, *Chemistry
- Communications Applications
- BCIS (technology requirement)
- Health

Student Enrollment:

- Students must receive approval from the OAC counselor.
- The class will be closed upon the class reaching enrollment of 25 students.
- Regular summer school attendance will be enforced. Students may be dismissed for non-attendance or for tardies.
- Students must adhere to the school dress code and behavior standards as outlined in the Katy ISD *Discipline Management Plan and Student Code of Conduct Handbook*. Students may be dismissed for unacceptable behavior.

Registration:

- Students **must complete registration** information prior to the first day of the summer session.
- There will be no fee for OAC Summer School.
- Students will complete courses in the order indicated on the enrollment form. Because this is a self-paced program, some students may not complete all courses listed on the enrollment form



Location:

- OAC High School Summer school will take place at Raines High School, located in the same building as the OAC.
- Transportation must be provided by the student or parent. Students eligible to drive will provide a driver's license and proof of insurance to the OAC front office on or before the first day of summer school attendance. Students who do not provide this information will not be permitted to drive to summer school.

Class Date and Times:

Daily, 7:30 a.m. until 1:30 p.m.
Monday through Thursday each week.

Lunch will not be provided. Students will have snack breaks & will be able to either bring snacks from home (in a clear bag) or use the vending machines to purchase snacks.

First Session:

6/15/through 7/02

Monday through Thursday

Second Session:

7/06 through 7/23

Monday through Thursday

Students who complete all of their assigned courses prior to the end of the summer session will not be required to maintain attendance through 7/17/07, but rather will be free to enjoy the rest of their summer.
