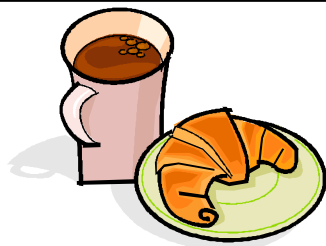
Thank you 5th Graders
