NOTES FROM THE NURSE

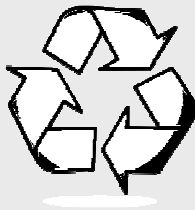

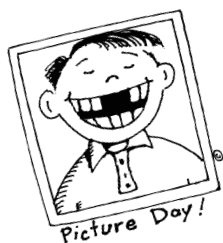
Due to a new district food service policy Pattison Elementary will no longer accept bills larger than a \$20.00.
